

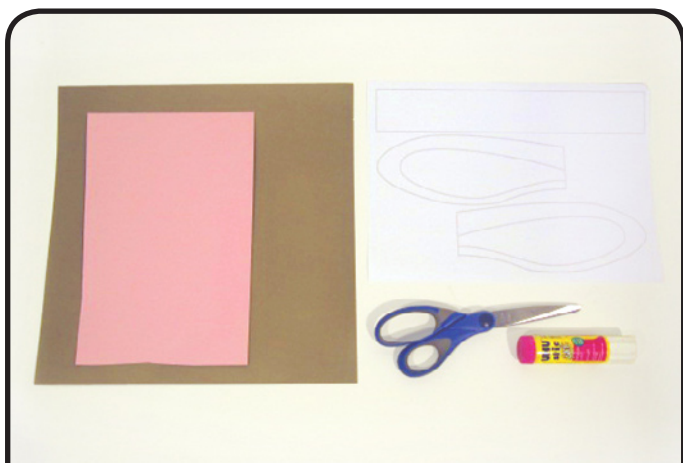
# Easter rabbit ears



### This activity kit contains:

1. Make and do activity steps 1 - 6
2. 1 template page

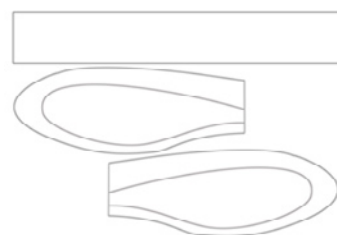


### Things you need:

- scissors
- stick glue or sticky tape
- light cardboard ( we used grey and pink )
- print 2 x the template

Note: This template can be used to colour in if you would like to create your own design of rabbit ears.

**1** Print your template **twice**. Cut out each piece. You should have: 2 headbands, 4 rabbit ears. Now cut out the inner ears from 1 of the pairs.



**2** Use 2 small spots of glue to attach the inner ear template pieces to pink card. Cut them out and carefully peel off the template.



**3** Use 2 small spots of glue to attach the large ear pieces and the 2 headband pieces to grey card. Cut out and carefully peel off the templates.



**4** Glue the pink inner ears on top of the grey outer ears.



**5** Join the 2 parts of the headband together with sticky tape or glue.



**6** Fit the headband to your head and stick it in place with glue or sticky tape. Arrange the ears behind the band and fix with sticky tape or glue.
