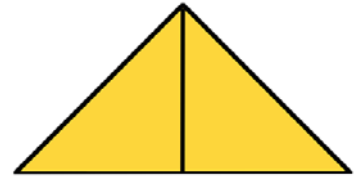
Things you need:

- scissors
- stick glue
- light cardboard - we used 30cm x 30cm
- small Easter eggs
- Tissue paper or cotton wool balls
- decorations - eyes, pipecleaners or colouring pens

1 Cut a piece of paper card 30cm x 30cm. Fold it in half to form a triangle.



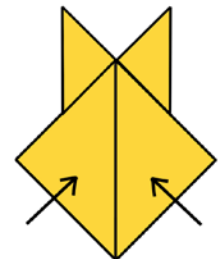
2 Fold your paper card in two. Then open it again. Place it with the point upwards, as shown.



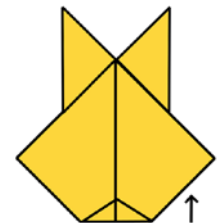
3 Fold the bottom or your triangle upwards, as shown to form a boat-like shape.



4 Fold each of the bottom corners, in the direction of the arrows shown. Keep the middle join very close.



5 To make a little stand for your rabbit, fold the bottom point upwards. Turn your rabbit over.



6 Glue eyes and whiskers on or draw the with pens. We used pipe cleaners and cardboard for our whiskers. Put shredded tissue paper into the top and full with eggs
