## This activity kit contains:

2. Three template pages

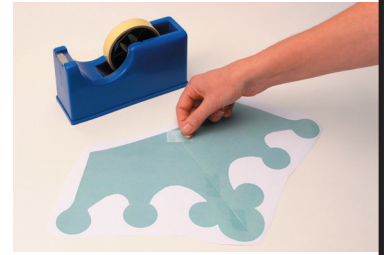

## Things you need:

- metallic or coloured card
- craft glue
- beads, jewels, or other decorations
- scissors & craft knife
- ruler
- stapler
- sticky-tape

- 1 Print out the crown templates, cut out the shapes and stick them together to make your crown pattern.



- 2 Sticky tape the pattern to the back of a sheet of cardboard. Cut out the crown with scissors.



- 3 Use the decorative motifs on the third template, beads, crystals, glitters or coloured and metallic papers to decorate your crown.



- 4 Cut out a band of cardboard about 3cm wide and 50cm long. Fit it to your head and staple the ends to the sides of the crown. Cut off the excess cardboard.



- 5 Place some sticky-tape over the staples to protect your skin from scratches.
