

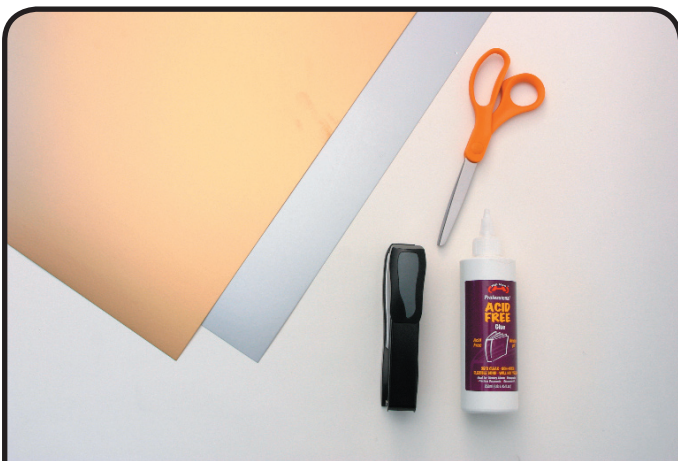
Samurai helmet



This activity kit contains:

1. Make and do activity steps 1 - 6
2. Four template pages

Things you need:

- two large sheets of metallic or coloured cardboard
- stapler
- glue
- scissors

1 Trace the helmet template onto coloured cardboard and cut out.



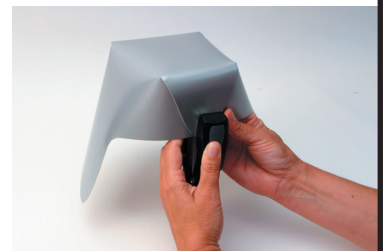
2 Pull together and overlap the back two side flaps of the template. Staple securely.



3 Pull the top flap over and staple it firmly to the other flaps.



4 Turn the helmet around and repeat steps 1 and 2 for the front flaps.



5 Using template 3, cut out the horn decoration using different coloured cardboard and staple to the middle of the helmet forehead.



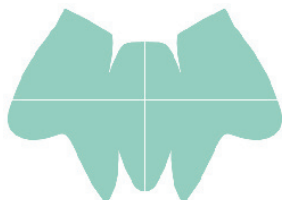
6 Cut out the side flaps and glue on the flower decorations. When they are dry, glue the side flaps to the helmet.



Template 1

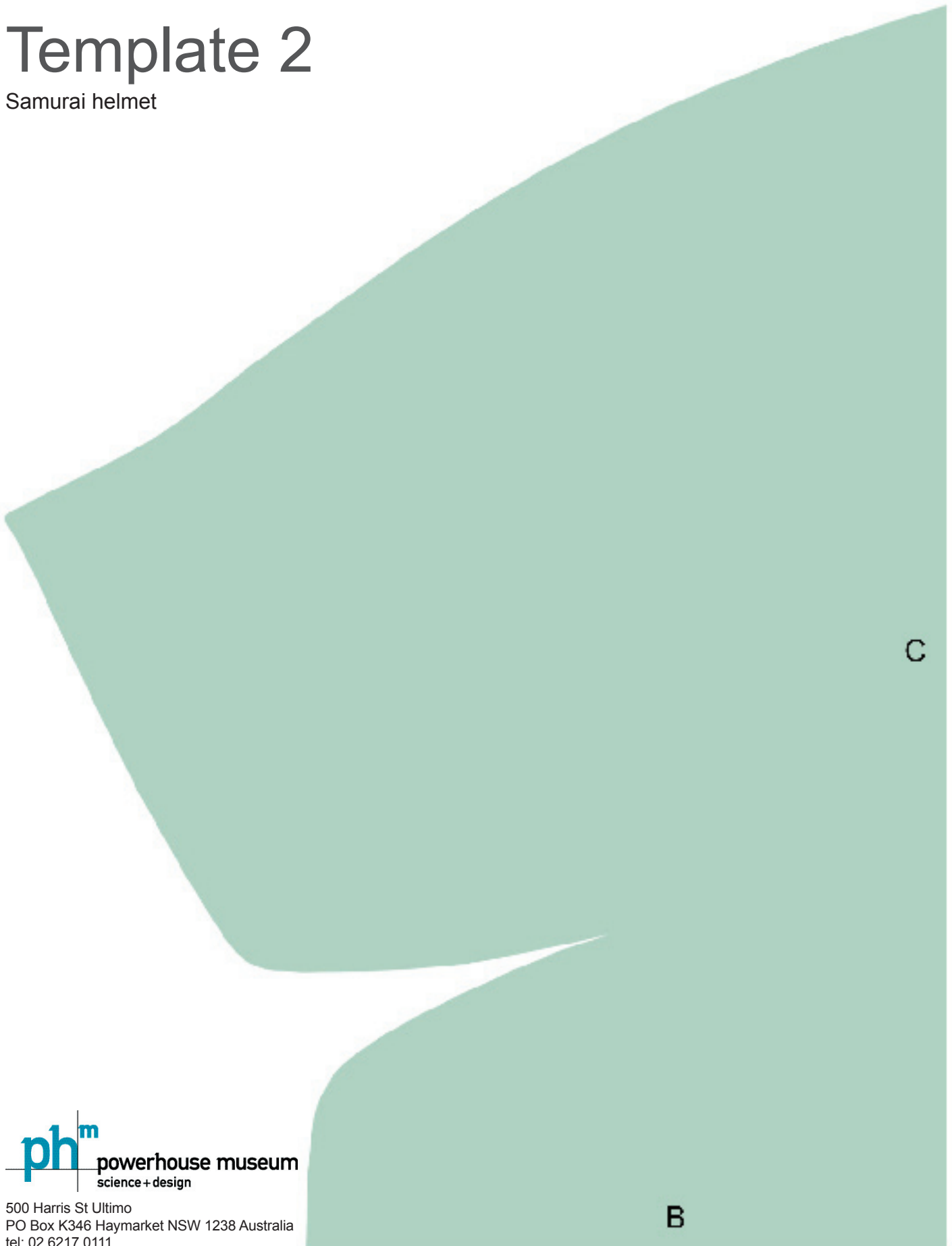
Samurai helmet:

1. Print two copies of templates 1 and 2.
2. Cut out the templates and turn one copy of each shape to the reverse side.
3. Stick the four shapes together, matching A-A, B-B then C-C.
3. Your finished template should look like the picture below.
4. Use this as a template to cut out your helmet shape from the metallic cardboard.

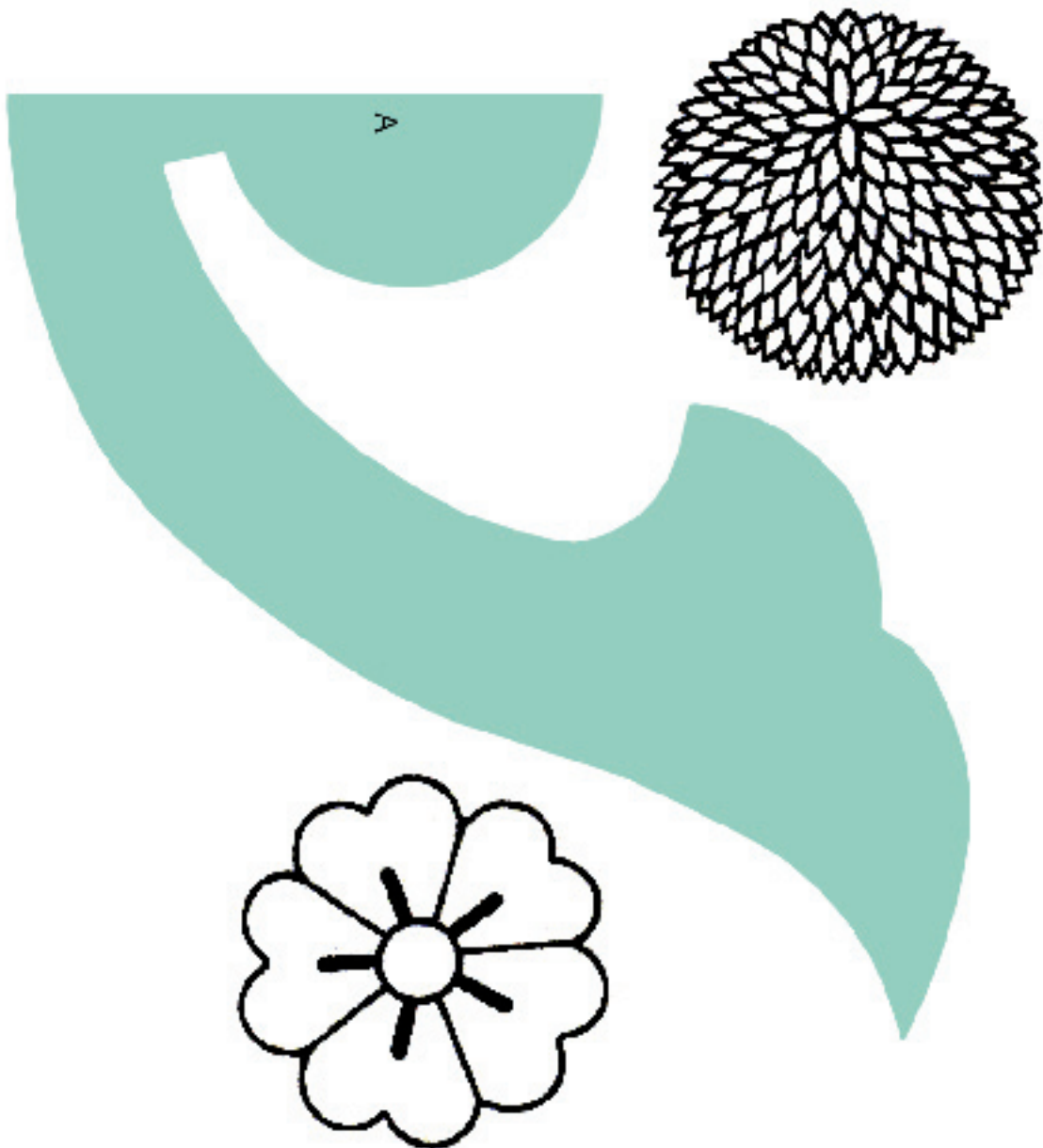
